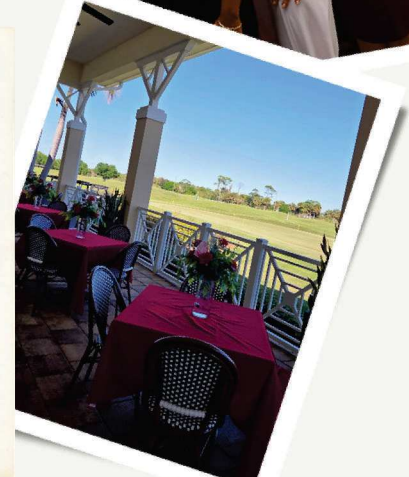
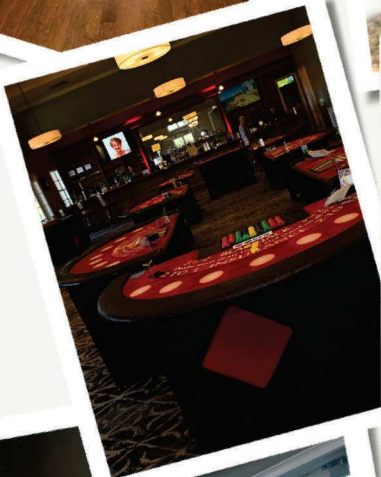

As a single mom of two after losing my husband, and later escaping an abusive relationship, my focus was entirely on keeping my children safe and cared for.
